Notice is hereby given that I offered for sale at public auction in Park Rapids, MN at 2:00 PM on Tuesday, May 7, 2024, timber belonging to the State of Minnesota. All tracts were offered at the Environmental Ed Building in Park Rapids, MN.

All of the timber offered was SFI and FSC certified.

The following pages list the lands upon which the timber was located, the estimated quantities of timber offered, the appraised prices, and the bid prices.

TERMS OF SALE

- This auction sale will be held according to Minnesota Statutes Sections 90.101 and 90.14. Timber shall be offered and sold by the same unit of measure as it was appraised. Sale shall be made to the responsible bidder who bids the highest price for all timber species advertised for bidding on each tract. Bidding above the appraised price shall be by increments of one (1) percent or more. The percent bid up will be added to the appraised price of each species indicated as a bid species by a plus symbol (+) on the Notice of Sale. Any or all bids may be rejected and sales canceled for good and sufficient reasons.

REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBLE BIDDERS

- Interested persons must be registered at least four (4) business days prior to the auction by submitting an *Annual Timber Sales Purchaser Registration* form. No bid will be accepted from anyone having a delinquent timber sale or trespass account or a willful timber trespass with any public agency in Minnesota, or from anyone who does not qualify as a Responsible Bidder as defined in Minnesota Statutes § 90.01 (12), or from anyone who has been debarred for cause by any public agency [M.S. § 90.041 (11)].

DOWN PAYMENT

- Purchasers of timber must pay a down payment of fifteen (15) percent of the appraised value of the timber at the time the purchaser's bid is approved. The down payment will be kept on deposit by the State and applied against any billings for timber. The purchaser may elect to have the down payment refunded if they post security for one hundred (100) percent of the bid price of the timber (see Security Required). If the purchaser does not sign the permit document within 45 days of sale, the down payment will forfeit to the State. A permit signature extension of 10 business days may be granted, provided the purchaser pays a \$200 penalty.

BID GUARANTEE

- For any bid increase in excess of \$10,000 of the appraised price, a bid guarantee equal to fifteen (15) percent of the total bid price of the timber less the down payment amount is required at the time the permit is signed. If the bid guarantee is not submitted with the signed permit, the permit cancels, and the down payment forfeits to the State. If the permit holder fails to execute an effective permit, the bid guarantee payment forfeits to the State.

PURCHASER AND LOGGER QUALIFICATIONS AND OPERATIONS REQUIREMENTS

- The purchaser or the purchaser's agents, employees, subcontractors, and assigns conducting logging operations on a timber permit must comply with the general industry safety standards for logging (e.g., LogSafe) adopted by the Commissioner of Labor and Industry and provide proof of compliance with these standards. The purchaser or the purchaser's agents, employees, subcontractors, and assigns conducting logging operations on a timber permit must comply with the State of Minnesota mandatory insurance requirements before harvest operations begin. A *Certification of Compliance with the Minnesota Workers' Compensation Law* form must be submitted each year. Before the start of harvest operations, the purchaser must certify that a designated foreperson, who will be supervising active logging operations, has a current certificate of completion from a logger education program (e.g., MLEP or FISTA) approved by the Commissioner of Natural Resources.

SECURITY REQUIRED

- The purchaser must furnish security equal to the total bid value of the permit, LESS the amount paid as a down payment and bid guarantee. Security can be furnished in the following forms: Corporate surety bond, Letter of Credit, certified check, cashier's check, personal check, money order, or by signing a Cutting Block Payment Agreement for individual cutting blocks, at least one business day prior to the start of any permit operations. If the purchaser elects to receive a refund of the down payment and bid guarantee, they must furnish security in a form described above, for one hundred (100) percent of the total bid value of the timber purchased. If the deferred cash payment for cutting blocks is selected, the down payment and bid guarantee WILL NOT be refunded. If the purchaser elects to secure a permit by prepayment of cutting block(s), they must make a written request on a form provided by the state. No harvesting is permitted until proper security has been furnished to and approved by the Commissioner of Natural Resources or his agent.

PERMIT TERMS

- A permit to harvest and remove the timber from state lands will be issued to the purchaser. NO permit shall be issued to anyone other than the purchaser in whose name the bid was made. All timber purchased on the permit must be harvested prior to the permit expiration date. All permits provide for the continuous identification of timber from the time of cutting until delivery to the consumer. Failure to continuously identify the timber as specified in the permit shall constitute trespass. Also, please note all harvest specifications on each tract being sold. Only one Regular Extension is permitted for exceptional circumstances. An annual interest rate of 5 percent may be charged on a regular extension for the period of the extension.

UNSOLD TRACTS

- On the next regular business day (8:00 AM - 4:30 PM, Monday - Friday, except holidays) after the date of the auction sale, unsold tracts may be available for over-the-counter purchase at the appraised price for a period of no more than one year. Unless canceled for reoffer at an earlier date, unsold tracts will be available until May 7, 2025, at the following Area Headquarters: Park Rapids Area.

Cutting and Felling:

- Harvest trembling aspen and jack pine in harvest area 1. In harvest area 2, harvest trembling aspen and yellow marked Norway pine. In harvest area 3, selectively harvest Norway pine down to 90 square feet per acre by removing poor quality and suppressed trees to release dominant, well-formed, single topped trees. Selection should provide equal spacing between reserve trees after removal by selecting them systematically throughout cutting area and not in clumps. Harvest trembling aspen and jack pine.

Season of Operations:

- Conduct sale operations on non rutting soil conditions only, except with written permission from State.

Sale Conditions:

- Access is across state land.

Marketing Conditions:

This sale is in the Huntersville state forest 4 miles west of Huntersville. There are access trails to all harvest areas. Harvest area 1 is 40-year-old trembling aspen and white spruce stand. Harvest area 2 is a 3rd thinning in 53-year-old Norway pine plantations. Harvest area 3 is a 2nd thinning in 34-year-old Norway pine plantations.

Cutting and Felling:

- Harvest jack pine, Norway pine, trembling aspen, paper birch, and red oak in harvest area 1. In harvest area 2, harvest jack pine, trembling aspen, paper birch and red oak.

- Reserve Norway pine and non-hazardous snags in harvest area 2.

- In harvest area 1, fell all snags and non-merchantable trees > 1" DBH.

Season of Operations:

- Conduct sale operations on non-rutting soil conditions only, except with written permission from State.

Slash Disposal:

- Lop and scatter slash evenly over the harvest site to within 2 feet of the ground.
- Keep a 30 foot slash free area around the permitter of harvest area 1 or where directed by the TSA.

Sale Conditions:

- Access is across State land.

Marketing Conditions:

This sale is located 4 miles south and 3 miles west of the Badoura State Nursery. The sale is north of the Hubbard Line Road. There is a woods trail that runs up the east side of the sale. The terrain is flat. The stands age is 48. Harvest Area 1 is dense and has a good amount non-merchantable jack pine that needs to be felled or ran over. A prescribe burn is planned after the harvest in harvest area 1, and there will be an extra emphasis on lop and scattering the slash evenly across the entire sale. There will be approximately 150 cords of dead jack pine available with an added timber agreement.

This stand is located 5 miles NW of Osage in the North Smoky Hills State Forest. This a final harvest of a mature Norway pine stands. There is good access to the stands with some trail improvement needed to the scattered parcels. The terrain is rolling throughout; however, it does not limit all season access.

Cutting and Felling:

- In harvest area 1, harvest trembling aspen, paper birch, and red maple. Harvest red oak greater than 8" DBH. In harvest area 2, harvest every 5th row. Harvest trees in remaining rows to a final stand BA of 90 square feet per acre by selecting trees of poor quality and suppressed trees to release dominant, well-formed, single topped trees. Selection should provide equal spacing between reserve trees after removal by selecting them systematically throughout cutting area and not in clumps. Trembling aspen, paper birch, and red maple should only be removed in access rows or when in direct competition to the crown of a red pine tree.

Season of Operations:

- Conduct sale operations on non-rutting soil conditions only, except with written permission from State.

Landings, Roads, and Trails:

- No slash or soil disturbance allowed on North Country Trail.

Sale Conditions:

- Access is across state land.

Marketing Conditions:

Sale is located in Paul Bunyan State Forest along Spur 1 forest road. Sale is comprised of a 7 acre 36 year old first entry pine thinning and 47 acres of 40 year old aspen clearcut. Terrain is rolling to steep.

Due to terrain there is limited space to land along access roads and trails. Construction of at least two landings will be need, and less than 1/4 mile of hunter/walking trail improved for access.

Approximately 7.5 miles secondary and 43 miles primary road to Solway, MN.
